Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India is executing a Scheme titled, "Scholarship Programme for Diaspora Children" [SPDC] for pursuing undergraduate courses where 150 scholarship would be given to the children of PIO/NRIs and children of Indian workers working in ECR countries studying in India and outside India.

2. The main objective of this scheme is to reach out to the candidates who are in need of financial assistance. Monthly gross income of the parents of desired candidates should not be more than US\$ 4500/-. **Guidelines for Academic Session 2018-2019 are enclosed:**

3. The following institutions are covered under the scheme:

- (i) National Institutes of Technology [NITs], Indian Institutes of Information Technology [IIITs], Schools of Planning and Architecture
- (ii) 'A' Grade Institutions accredited by National assessment and Accreditation Council [NAAC] and recognized by UGC
- (iii) Central Universities of India
- (iv) Other institutions covered under Direct Admission of Student Abroad [DASA] scheme.

4. Under this scheme, the partial financial assistance to the extent of 75% of the total Institutional Economic Cost (IEC) subject to a maximum of US\$4500/- per annum would be borne by the Government of India.

5. It is requested that the information of this Scheme may kindly be disseminated, as much as possible, amongst the Indian Community so that the benefit of this scholarship be availed by the desirable candidates.
