Sending-off Ceremony for 'Team Maldives for India Athletic Training Camp 2023'





13th January 2023, a Sending-off Ceremony for 'Team Maldives for India Athletic Training Camp 2023' was organised by Athletics Association of Maldives at the iconic Ekuveni Synthetic Track Ground in Male. 10 athletes and 03 coaches are going to India to attend a 6-month long athletic camp at Netaji Subhash Sports Authority of India (SAI) Bengaluru from Jan 2023 to Aug 2023. Netaji Subhash Sports Authority of India Bengaluru is a premier institute under Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India.

The event was graced by H.E. Ahmed Mahloof, Minister of Youth, Sports & Community Empowerment, High Commissioner of India Munu Mahawar, Mr. Ahmed Saleem, Commissioner of Sports and Mr. Ahmed Azeel, Vice President, Athletics Association of Maldives, among others. The event also had the presence of Maldives' Men and Women Athletic Teams and sports enthusiasts.
