8th Ayurveda Day, November 13, 2023:ICC Male, High Commission of India, Maldives observed the 8th Ayurveda Day on the 13th of November, 2023 (that falls on 10th November every year) at the Indian Cultural Centre in collaboration with Ayurvedic Therapy, a registered Ayurvedic wellness clinic under the Ministry of Health, Maldives with presentations in both Dhivehi language and in English, a Q& A session by the Presenters, a music therapy session conducted by the ICC music teacher, presentation of certificates to the Presenters and ended with networking over healthy refreshments. The event which saw a significant turnout with active participation from local people as well as members of the Indian community garnered a lot of interest and appreciation due to its insightful and informative content was graced by the High Commissioner of India to Maldives, HE Mr. Manu Mahawar and attended by senior officials from the Ministry of Health, Maldives.

The presentations by Dr. Archana Birajdar, an Ayurvedic doctor and Ayurvedic Therapy Presenters explored how Ayurveda extends beyond treatment, aiming for holistic healing and well-being of the human body, how lifestyle diseases can be treated with the fundamental principles of Ayurveda and the importance of balance in the three doshas. The music therapy session with its immersive and uplifting experience proved to be another highlight.
