

Tabla Workshop at ICC, December 17, 2023: In the third tabla workshop organised by ICC Male, High Commission of India, Republic of Maldives on December 17, 2023 on 'CORRELATION BETWEEN TAAL, THEKA AND LYRICAL EXPRESSIONS OF A COMPOSITION', conducted by the ICC music teacher, the intricately correlation between taal, theka and lyrical expressions within a song composition was explored with precision. Through extensive demonstrations and explanations, it was elucidated that Taal, the rhythmic framework, serves as the heartbeat, dictating the tempo and structure of the musical piece. Theka, the specific drumming pattern played on the tabla, intricately weaves into the taal, providing a rhythmic canvas for the melodic elements. This symbiotic relationship between taal and theka is fundamental in establishing the rhythmic foundation of the composition. Concurrently, lyrical expressions, conveyed through vocal or instrumental elements, find resonance within this rhythmic framework.

The workshop, as always was hugely appreciated by the participants, few if whom notable senior singers of Maldives who made the session extremely interactive by engaging the teacher with their individualistic musical queries and inputs. The participants have requested for detailed discussions in future on various other aspects of music.
