

Medical Scholarships

In terms of the Memorandum of Understanding signed on 15 October 2001 the Government of India is assisting Government of Maldives by training Maldivian nationals to enable them to occupy suitable positions in the Indira Gandhi Memorial Hospital(IGMH). The training in India covers Post-Graduate students, MBBS, Nursing and in few cases technical/administrative skills like Hospital management, Store Keeping and Laundry Management, through in-service training essentially. All personnel trained in India under this MoU will serve in the IGMH for a specified period.

Since 2002 under Aid to Maldives programme of the Ministry of External Affairs (ITEC/IGMH Scheme), the Maldivian nationals are offered admissions to One Post Graduate (MD/MS/MCH) and four MBBS degree courses annually in various Medical Colleges in India. The Government of India pays for tuition, living, book/hostel allowance and University/student activity fees. The international air passage is borne by the Government of Maldives.

Duly filled application forms (in duplicate) routed through Ministry of Foreign Affairs should reach the High Commission at least six months prior to the commencement of the respective courses
