ANNOUNCEMENT

The High Commission of India is pleased to inform that the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Cyprus Institute of Neurology and Genetics (CING) of the Republic of Cyprus have jointly offered scholarships for up to three (3) postgraduate (MSc) (depending on availability) to Indian nationals for the Academic Year 2024-25.

Each scholarship covers:

- Full tuition fees (€ 8000) for citizens who will apply and are accepted based on the CING academic criteria. Candidates will be evaluated on their academic qualifications, provided they fulfill the CING entry requirements.
- Stipend to cover accommodation and living expenses in Cyprus. A minimum stipend of € 1375 will be offered to every successful student. The stipend can be increased up to € 8000/student depending on the availability of funds. All students will be informed upon acceptance to the CING.

1. MSc in Molecular Medicine
2. MSc in Medical Genetics
3. MSc in Neuroscience
4. MSc in Biotechnology
